### Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

Today's Feast of the Holy Family highlights the importance of family, both in imagery and in history, for understanding God's relationship with humankind. The readings begin in First Samuel with Hannah expressing her thankfulness for God's response to her open petition. She remains faithful to her promise and returns the gift of her child Samuel in consecration to God. Samuel, in turn, becomes one of God's key prophetic spokespeople. Together they present a unique model of family.

Luke's Gospel focuses on the one episode Scripture preserves of Jesus' childhood. Jesus was drawn to those from whom he could learn and grow, though it caused concern for his family. Sometimes such hunches take us outside our boxes, as well as those of our family and of our society. This may lead us to the path of finding authentic relationship with God broadening our understanding of family.
